Cabinet Meetings - order of business

Prime Minister's address:

Pick eight news cards. Hand one to each player announcing to the rest of the cabinet what news the minister must deliver. Ministers must keep score cards visible to the rest of the cabinet.

Any other business:

Minister's chance to plot to get rid of a the PM.

NB. The following stages may not occur in every meeting.

Motion for vote of no confidence:

The minister officially bringing forward the motion must recommend an alternative other than themselves for PM.

PM's defence:

The PM's defence are the final words spoken before the vote.

New PM and Reshuffle:

The new PM may reshuffle his cabinet before the start of the next meeting. All ministers must move to the correct table position taking their score cards with them. The new PM has one extra reshuffle in hand which can only be used before the Prime Minister's address of any meeting.
