It is here-by agreed by the Seconds of both Parties that this matter will be settled by a Duel:

* untill the Offended Party is satisfied
* untill First Blood drawn
* to the Death I
using:
* Swords
within an arena of Paces across
* Firearms
at a distance ofPaces ²
* firing alternately, with the Offending Party firing first
* firing alternately, with the Challenged Party firing first
* with both Parties firing simultaneously
* for a total of Shots
* until Ammunition is exhausted
In addition, the following special conditions will pertain:

- 1. NB that the Deceased may take no further part in Duelling.
- 2. Two (2) paces if Short Range; Five (5) paces if Long Range.
