Being a concise Description of

THE AGREED ROLES OF DOELLING,

as understood by all Right-Thinking Gentlemen

(and certain Un-Lady-Like Women):-



- 1. To turn down a Challenge is to forfeit a Point of Honour.
- 2. Each Duellist must appoint a Second to negotiate the details of the Duel, and abide by the agreed Terms, or forfeit a Point of Honour.
- 3. The Winner of a Duel gains a Point of Honour from the Loser, and must pay the Winner's Second £100 for his trouble.
- 4. Excepting That:- In the event of a Fatal Duel, the Winner takes all the Loser's Honour, and the Loser's appointed Second inherits his Monies to make Funeral Arrangements.
- 5. At the end of the Duelling, a "Cash-for-Honours" System will operate, with each Point of Honour costing £200.
