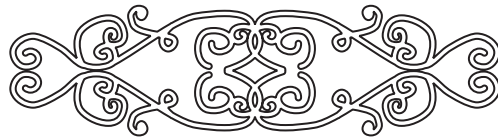


CODE DUELLO

Being a concife Description of
THE AGREED RULES OF DUELLING,
as understood by all *Right-Thinking Gentlemen*
(and certain *Un-Lady-Like Women*):-



1. To turn down a Challenge is to forfeit a Point of Honour.
2. Each Duellist must appoint a Second to negotiate the details of the Duel, and abide by the agreed Terms, or forfeit a Point of Honour.
3. The Winner of a Duel gains a Point of Honour from the Loser, and must pay the Winner's Second £100 for his trouble.
4. *Excepting That:-* In the event of a Fatal Duel, the Winner takes all the Loser's Honour, and the Loser's appointed Second inherits his Monies to make Funeral Arrangements.
5. At the end of the Duelling, a "Cash-for-Honours" System will operate, with each Point of Honour costing £200.
